

FFA Foundation Scholarship Program Follow-up

Oklahoma FFA Foundation scholarships will be awarded to FFA members when they show proof of attendance at any university, college, or junior college after graduation from high school.

Upon graduation from high school, the following is required of the recipient by the Oklahoma FFA Foundation to receive your scholarship.

Requirements for the Academy Scholarship are somewhat different.

1. August – Send a copy of your first semester postsecondary class schedule and a brief letter requesting the first half of your scholarship.
2. August – The Oklahoma FFA Foundation will mail the first half of your scholarship to the Bursar’s office of the higher education institution you have selected and it will be directly deposited into your account.
3. December – Send a copy of your second semester postsecondary class schedule and a brief letter requesting the second half of your scholarship. Also, send a copy of your first semester postsecondary transcript. You must have achieved a 2.0 cumulative GPA the first semester to qualify for the second payment.
4. January – The Oklahoma FFA Foundation will mail the second half of your scholarship directly to you.

To receive the \$1,000 Future Ag-Ed Teacher Academy Scholarship:

1. Attend all five days of the Academy.
2. Be admitted to Oklahoma State University within three years after graduation from high school.
3. Select the Agricultural Education teaching option as your OSU college major.
4. Forward a copy of the first semester OSU transcript, showing a 2.5 or higher GPA, to the Executive Director of the Oklahoma FFA Foundation. A \$1,000 scholarship check will be mailed directly to the participant.
