OKLAHOMA FFA HALL OF CHAPTERS

The heart of FFA lives at the local level and so does its 100 year history!

To commemorate the 100th Annual Oklahoma State FFA Convention, the Oklahoma FFA Association is inviting chapters to tell their story through participation in the Hall of Chapters.

The Hall of Chapters will be located on the north side of the Expo in the Pepsi Exhibit Hall at the Arvest Convention Center, opposite the Talent Stage.

Each participating chapter will be provided one 6-foot skirted table to decorate and use to showcase its chapter history. Displays may include chapter scrapbooks, historical artifacts, original charters, alumni FFA jackets, photographs, and similar items. Chapters are encouraged to be as creative as possible. (*A State Fair educational booth would work, or you may think outside the box!*) This is your opportunity to highlight your chapter's legacy as we celebrate 100 years of Oklahoma FFA.

Due to limited space, participation is limited to 125 chapters and will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Chapters must sign up by **March 1**. The registration link can be found below.

The Oklahoma FFA Alumni Association will provide cash awards and plaques to the top three participating chapters:

- First Place: \$500
- Second Place: \$250
- Third Place: \$150

Tables will be judged on overall presentation, creativity, and historical storytelling, including clear identification of the chapter name. Access to electricity will not be available at these tables.

Participating chapters must plan to arrive and set up their displays during one of the following approved times:

- **Monday, May 4, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** (loading dock access available)
- **Tuesday, May 5, from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.** (walk in items only)
- **Tables must remain in place until 4:00 p.m. Wednesday, May 6.**

Courtesy Corps will be stationed at the Hall of Chapters throughout the convention and will make every effort to prevent damage or removal of items. However, the Oklahoma FFA Association is not responsible for lost or damaged property.
